

## GUIDANCE - STAFFORDSHIRE GLAUCOMA ECF REFERRALS

### **REFERRALS TO ECF PATHWAY VIA PES CENTRAL HUB**

#### **Non-participating GRM practice:**

- IOP  $\geq 24$ mmHg:
  - not repeated
  - repeated but not using GAT / Perkins
  - first repeat using GAT / Perkins and not repeated on another day
- IOP's  $< 24$ mmHg with suspicious Visual Fields indicative of a glaucomatous loss not repeated on another day

#### **Non-participating ECF practice:**

- Suspicious discs/disc asymmetry **and** IOP  $< 24$  mmHg (GAT)
- Narrow/Occludable angles
- Any PDS/Pseudoexfoliation with IOP  $< 21$ mmHg

### **REFERRALS DIRECT TO HES (FOLLOW LOCAL PROTOCOLS)**

- Suspicion of Glaucomatous Disc changes with IOP  $> 24$ mmHg and/or a glaucomatous visual field defect
- Any PDS/PXF with IOP  $> 21$ mmHg
- IOP's  $> 32$ mmHg
- Acute Angle Closure
- Rubeotic Glaucoma
- Domiciliary patients
